The prominent yew waymarking where the track turns uphill, from near the edge of Baysbrown Wood.



Prominent, indeed – the yew is bigger than expected once you come close. Its heavy double trunk is braced and fused, strengthened over time to withstand whatever the upland weather brings.



Wander down from the track to appreciate this old giant, still as solid now as always, quietly overlooking Chapel Stile and the valley of Great Langdale.
