Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



The 'larch plantation' below Swine Crag, seen from the grassy path ascending towards the 'split boulder' and the high step-over stile on the intake wall.



Enter the 'larch plantation' via the gate in the wall at lower left, passing the shallow rocky ravine of Whitegill Crag descending on your right.



The larch provide cool shade, shelter and security for people and animals alike. They appear somewhat dilapidated and forlorn, but create a sense of peace and serenity beyond the milling crowds around the hotel and on the paths heading higher towards the Langdales.
