A handsome wych elm, embedded in the rocks of the stream bank and boundary wall, reaches out to the quiet path you pass by on.



Emerging from the wooded slopes of Troutdale arrive at the edge of Long Moss, to follow the curving path towards King's How, where the yew greets you.



Early summer bright lime-green tips colour AW's 'yew' in a shining bronze-green aura, in contrast to the surrounding broadleaf trees.
