

3.3 Calf Crag 3

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



From around Jackdaw Crag in Easedale, streamside holly trees intermixed with ash, birch and rowan accompany Far Easdale Gill into the upper valley of Far Easedale.



Unassuming, but always attractive – with variable leaf shapes (usually, spiny all over when browsed and/or in shade at lower levels – or plain and unpointed higher in the crown and where in full sun).



From Stythwaite Steps, looking northwest into the upper reaches of Far Easedale with Calf Crag, Tarn Crag, Gibson Knott, Helm Crag and their environs enclosing the valley.
