Looking to Slight Side from beyond the crossing of Catcove Beck, expecting the solitary hawthorn to stand somewhere between the unseen first and second stream draining from the left-hand slope. Appearances are deceptive – the grassland is not flat – aside from the main gullies of the four becks there is much dead ground from innumerable runnels and channels between this point and the cairn on boulder seen distantly ahead on the track, near the edge of the upper patch of bracken.
