Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



The pines, a small plantation seen at middle centre, is immediately in view across Watendlath Tarn on the facing slope of Watendlath Fell, with Middle Crag on the left, Great Crag to the right and the uplands of Ullscarf in the far distance at upper centre.



Approaching the pines from Black Waugh's woodland.



The mixed larch and pine plantation, with a bonus solitary spruce. Notice the amount of fallen debris strewn throughout the plantation – and take care accordingly.



Looking north to Watendlath Tarn, from the Sitka spruce. Dead wood and broken branches or trunks lie everywhere, with more material hung-up above – meaning this is not a safe place to idle time away if the weather is bad and the wind is blowing.
