

2.5 Troutbeck Tongue 2

The ancient cairn lies partially obscured in an immense field of bog grass, but once located presents as an interesting feature. Looking north to the source of Trout Beck, below Threshthwaite Mouth (obscured by low cloud).



Many stones have been dispersed, meaning the site is greatly disturbed. Two low, mounded, rock shelters are obvious, though both are dilapidated.
