

4.9 Pike O'Blisco 7

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Once on the skirting track, first locate the ruin, seen here on the edge of Blea Moss – in summer almost covered and hidden by head-high bracken.



Scan the fall-line of the gully for the likeliest path of ascent, noting AW's two holly trees above you, sited to the left and right (albeit now joined by a third holly, at centre).



Viewing upwards from a slightly different angle clearly reveals the additional trees growing in the vicinity of the two original hollies – an entirely natural proliferation of trees on the fellside, wherever conditions are suitable.
