

3.5 Grange Fell 4

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



The tree stands over the fallen and ruined 'hut (shelter)' now virtually obscured within a sloping field of mid-summer bracken.



Looking back across the open ground above the lower plantation the solitary hawthorn is obvious, standing alone, upslope and separate from the conifers, beneath the ascending slopes of Brund Fell.



Once a waymarker along the original path – now a lone hawthorn quietly declining and far from the route taken by many heading to Brund Fell and King's How.
