

## 2.2 Beda Fell 3 and 6

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



From a position similar to AW's original drawing *Beda Fell from Martindale Old Church*, after around seven decades, the ancient, sombre but beautiful European yew (with a smaller partner to the right) still stands at the rear-left of the enclosure – with views beyond to Beda Fell.



Birkett's tomb, sheltered by the shrouding canopy of the yew – aged, yet ageless – both remain in perpetuity in this quiet solemn place.



The tiny Martindale Old Church, below Steel Knotts, with its ancient yew behind and a pair of contemporary red oak framing the entrance.
