Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Arriving at the summit's observation tower and standing back from the view presented by AW, the entire 'willow' – a goat willow – is far more substantial than expected. Its leaning trunk divides into upright branches that form a crouching, broad-spreading, wind-shaped crown.



The observation tower identifies Bigland Barrow from any direction – and the accompanying waymarker willow doubly confirms the summit to all who walk its open airy top.
