Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Once up on the Terrace Route, look north-eastwards into the upper reaches of Eskdale to spot AW's waymarker yew (from Crinkle Crags 8) ... almost dead-centre, amongst bracken on the far side of the valley ... a mere dot in the distance.



From near Catcove Beck, looking north across the expanse of Quagrigg Moss to Slight Side. The damp grassy path lies ahead and is a fairly straight line to the cairn on boulder standing just at the edge of the bracken, seen in the distant sunshine. Alas, there is no solitary hawthorn. Unless ...?
