Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



The higher of the two rowans, at the head of the gill – displaying thinning foliage as the late summer turns to autumn. It appears to be strong, with functioning leaves and sound wood, at least for now.



From above, looking down past the upper tree, the lower rowan (actually two trees, in reality) is below on the right-hand bank (seen slightly left of centre) overhanging the stony bed of Near Broken Gill. Other small trees are in the vicinity, on the opposite (left) bank and further down the gully.
