

3.12 Silver How 4

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Above Score Crag, the path beside Wray Gill leads into the well-defined zone of juniper. Occasional low-growing sessile oak and holly occur, otherwise juniper dominate this area.



Many juniper are growing in groundcover or shrub forms – plus there are frequent examples of 5-6m high upright tree-like plants in the vicinity.



Winter snows and storm winds have wrecked some juniper – though signs of new growth and young seedlings are found amongst the canopies of older trees.
