

7.2 Gavel Fell 6

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



The rowan stands upon a rock mount, clear of the water – yet immediately below the point where the torrents of Comb Gill and Grain Gill meet – bringing damaging debris and flood whenever in spate.



The watersmeet beneath the rowan joins into Croasdale Beck (flowing to the right), descending westwards below Banna Fell (in the background) and Godworth. A fulsome and healthy goat willow just downstream is unaffected by the cascading force of the upper gills.
