Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Beyond The Rake the first self-set straggly European larch appear, soon followed by these outliers on the edge of the main plantation.



Looking west, beyond the larch, to Sheffield Pike.



The view north/northeast, to Gowbarrow Fell and Ullswater's far northern reaches.



Straw-coloured shoots hold blunt-ovoid cones with rounded overlapping scales for several years after seeds are released, while deciduous leaves – singular and spirally arranged on new growth tips and in short dense tufted whorls on older wood – appear elegant from spring to autumn.
