

## 7.8 Scoat Fell 6

Images from the walk to the waymarker tree.



Looking into Mosedale, below Yewbarrow, with the slopes of Red Pike (Wasdale) on the left, the flanks of Kirk Fell to the right and Pillar dominating the view ahead.



The first waymarker rowan, beside Mosedale Beck and some distance before the gorge proper – looking back down Mosedale, across the eastern slopes around Black Sail Pass to the rounded summit of Kirk Fell – with the Scafell group to the right.



Looking up into the steepening ground of the gorge on the ascent, beneath Blackem Head (right) and the Red Pike (Wasdale) (rear left) and Scoat Fell (rear right) skyline, above the first waymarker rowan.



In the 'rowan-bedecked gorge' ... *upper*: a rowan spreads above a low, tangled sycamore, their trunks almost entwined; *middle*: living and dead trees line both sides of the beck; and *lower*: observe the growth of numerous rowan saplings, taking their place in the steep recesses of the ravine.
